Everything is a Priority


- Work was prioritized... but never getting done

- Throughput, WIP, cycle time
- Limited projects in work




Missed Our Promise Dates Struggling to Keep Making Realistic Commitments Commitments

- Estimation 3-6 weeks lead time
- Departmental Managers
- Teams not included in estimation but held to promise dates
- No feedback loop

Large Scale Estimation Using Historical Reference Library

- Estimation 1-2 days
- The people doing the work, size the work
- +/- 10% accuracy



Paralysis by Analysis Legacy Business Case

- 10 to 20 year pay-back period
- Overplanning / erroneous assumptions
- Baselined before enough information was known
- Some projects need to be terminated but left open



Emerging Business Case

Actual Business Value Using Historical Reference Library

- Initial funding and "kill point"
- Experiment / show working product
- Marketing Team could demonstrate real product to customers
